

RING SIZE GUIDE

BEFORE YOU BEGIN


For the most accurate ring size please review your printer settings first. Page scaling should be set to "none" and PDF prints at 100%. To confirm the precision of the printout, use a ruler to measure the 1 inch or 3 centimeter markers in the sample box. If this doesn't match exactly, your ring size measurement will be inaccurate.



HOW TO MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE


OPTION 1: MEASURE BY MATCHING YOUR CURRENT RING

- 1. Select a ring you already own that perfectly fits the finger on which you will wear your SILK ring.
- 2. Align your ring with the circle below that mostly closely matches in size.
- 3. The inner edge of your ring should align with the outer edge of the circle. The number that can be read in the middle is your ring size. If the ring falls between two sizes, we advise you to order the larger size.



OPTION 2: MEASURE YOUR FINGER SIZE WITH PAPER SIZER

- 1. Cut along the outline of the sizer. Make a small slit on the line on the left end of the sizer.
- 2. Wrap the sizer around the largest part of your finger with the numbers facing out.
- 3. Pull the pointed end of the sizer through the slit. Make sure it fits snugly for accuracy.
- 4. The number that lines up with the slit represents the ring circumfrence for that finger.
- 5. Now look up your SILK ring size in the table below.
